Michael's Story



On July 21 2016, at just 16 years old, Michael died during a school organised cycling pilgrimage to Santiago de Compostela in Spain.

Despite being physically fit, Michael suffered from an undiagnosed heart condition and died completely unexpectedly and tragically from a suspected heart attack.

Michael was thoroughly enjoying his life; full of dreams and ambitions and getting ready to embark on a career in healthcare with his plan of taking up medicine in university.

He loved serving God as an altar server since he was seven, first at the Sacred Heart Parish in Morriston, Swansea, and then at the Cathedral Church of St. Joseph's in Swansea.

He enjoyed working with children in his role as a Volunteer Youth Helper with the HCPT, a charitable organisation that gives life-changing pilgrimage holidays to Lourdes, France for disabled and disadvantaged children and adults.







As is so often the case, his family learned a great deal more about him from the stories of friends and those who knew him in different ways. They talk of his gentleness and unfailing consideration for others, of those qualities that earned him the description of being true gentleman.

Others saw in him the simple faith that made his life so worthwhile, so fulfilled and so rewarding. He demonstrated so naturally his belief in Christian values and morality and for those who recognise him only from his duties as an altar server no one could have doubted his absolute sincerity.


Perhaps what illustrates his qualities better than anything was the account of one of his fellow helpers on an HCPT trip to Lourdes when Michael gave his own shoes to a young pilgrim whose shoes were wet. What most touched that witness was that Michael continued the journey barefoot and without complaint.

ORGANISING YOUR EVENT

- Decide what kind of event you want to do, or how you want to go about raising funds. Why not hold an event at your sports club or at school. Alternatively, you could hold a racing event with some friends.
- Think about where you could hold your event. Think about where there could be some good cycle paths local to you, or alternatively, could you cycle at the gym?
- When will you hold your event? Think about whether it's better to hold your event on a weekend or weekday. Allow yourself enough time to properly plan your event to get the most out of it.

 Consider whether other events or national holidays may clash with your event.
 - How can you make the most out of your fundraising? You may want to set yourself a target amount of how much you want to raise to keep you focused, but remember to be realistic with your target.
 - Spread the word and make sure everyone knows about your event. You could create posters or leaflets and ask shops, restaurants, gyms and other local businesses to display them. Social media is also a great way to get the word out about your event.







ORGANISING YOUR EVENT

- You may want to contact your local newspaper or radio station to garner a bit of publicity for your event. Let them know what you're doing and why you're supporting the Michael Cura Appeal.
- Get in touch with local businesses to see if they can help you by sponsoring you or donating a raffle/auction prize. You may also be able to get your venue at a reduced cost or even free since it's for a charity event. Get your friends and family involved if you like, and decide who is going to be responsible for each task.
- Social media channels are not only a fantastic way to spread the word about your event, but you can also set up a fundraiser on Facebook so people can donate that way. Or, you can set up an online sponsorship page using websites such as JustGiving.
- We can arrange some bucket collections and tins if you need them, as well as Calon Hearts information flyers, t-shirts, and other merchandise. Email us at info@calonhearts.org to arrange this.
- Once your event is over, please collect the money you have raised and send it in to us. If you would like us to feature you on our website and social media channels, don't forget to send us any photos you have, so we can thank you for all your hard work.
